SS. Cosmas and Damian were twin brothers born in Arabia. After studying medicine in Syria, they lived in Aegeae, Cilicia and became greatly renowned for their medical skills, as well as for their refusal to accept payment from anyone for their services.

During a persecution of Christians (around 303 AD), these devout men were arrested, tried before the Cilician governor, Lysias, and beheaded for their faith in Christ. Also put to death with them were their three brothers, Anthimus, Euprepius and Leontius.

Since the time of their martyrdom, many miracles have been reported, especially miracles of healing. SS. Cosmas and Damian are the Patrons of Physicians, Pharmacists and Barbers.

WHAT IS THE WHITE MASS?

Saints Cosmas and Damian were twins, one was a Doctor and one was a Pharmacist. They are Patrons of Doctors, Pharmacists, Nurses and all other members of the Medical Professions. As a result we have instituted a Mass of Thanksgiving on the first night of our Triduum in gratitude for all members of the Medical Professions at 7:00 P.M. on September 27th celebrated by our Guest Homilist, Rev. Monsignor John C. Marine, MDiv., Pastor, St. Bede the Venerable Church, Holland, PA. The SS. Cosmas and Damian Choir will provide the music.


