

Affidavit of Probable Cause

Arrest of Austin Parkinson and Lana Lane

On Monday, November 20, 2017 at 5:46 PM, the Plymouth Township Police Department responded to a vehicle crash in the parking lot of 410 Ridge Pike, in the Conshohocken section of Plymouth Township.

Plymouth Township Police Officer DeSantis arrived on scene and observed that the operator of 2012 Buick sedan, was deceased and that the vehicle was in drive, stopped against a parked vehicle. The victim was identified as Chad Akeen Konata, age 31 of Collingdale PA. Konata appeared to have been stabbed multiple times in the torso.

The Plymouth Township Police Department and the Montgomery County Detective Bureau commenced a joint investigation into this apparent homicide. The 2012 Buick sedan and surrounding areas were secured as a crime scene.

Plymouth Township Police Detectives Anthony Costello and Andrew Moretti gathered video surveillance from numerous locations surrounding the crime scene. The surveillance depicts the 2012 Buick sedan entering the parking lot at 410 Ridge Pike at approximately 5:06 PM. While parked in the lot, Konata was confronted by (2) suspects who approached on foot from the parking lot of the Outback Steak House, located at 322 Ridge Pike. The (2) suspects are seen running back toward the Outback Steakhouse. One of the suspect's, appears to be limping while running from the scene. Konata then drove across a parking lot and struck a parked vehicle. The Buick remained at that location until police arrived on scene.

Detectives followed the path from where the suspects fled and observed a trail of blood leading from where the Buick sedan was parked at the time of the stabbing, into a parking space on the east side of the Outback Steakhouse. Based upon the quantity of blood at the scene, it appears the suspect may require medical treatment for the injury

Montgomery County Detective Albert Dinnell, a member of the Forensic Service Unit processed the crime scene to include the Buick sedan and surrounding parking lots. During scene processing, Detective Dinnell recovered (2) cellular phones inside the Buick sedan. After removing the victim from the vehicle, (2) knives were located beneath his
