- Number of Days in Operation: 20
- Total Number of Rides Provided: 90
- Amount Collected in Fares: \$162.00

Adults buying individual tickets, using a 10-trip pass and represent 71 of the 90 total rides. Nearly two-thirds of the total rides occurred on a Friday or Saturday.

The majority of the rides in February were on the daytime route. 63 total rides were provided from 11 am–6 pm on Wednesday–Saturday and on Sunday. 27 rides were provided from 6 pm–11 pm on Wednesday–Saturday.

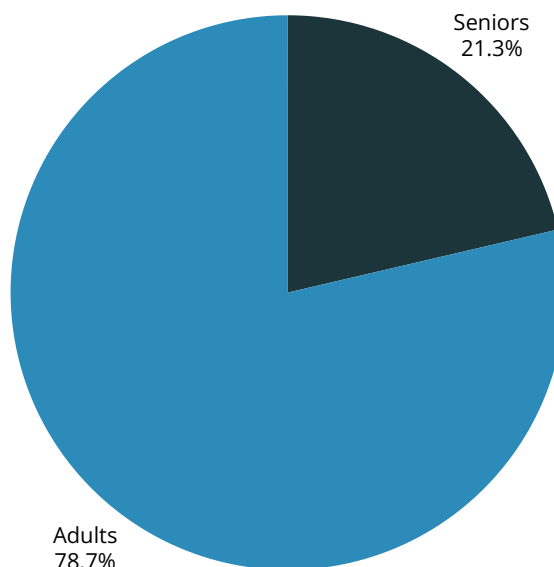
Popular stops on the daytime route were Giant and the SEPTA Station. The most popular stop on the evening route was Bar Lucca.

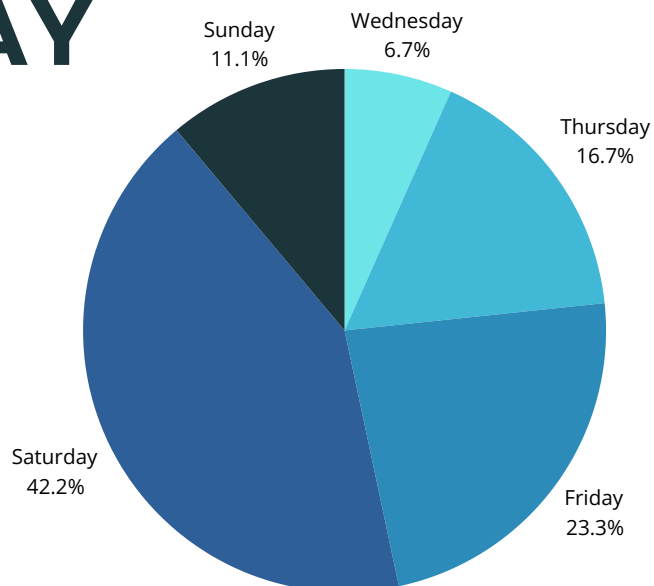

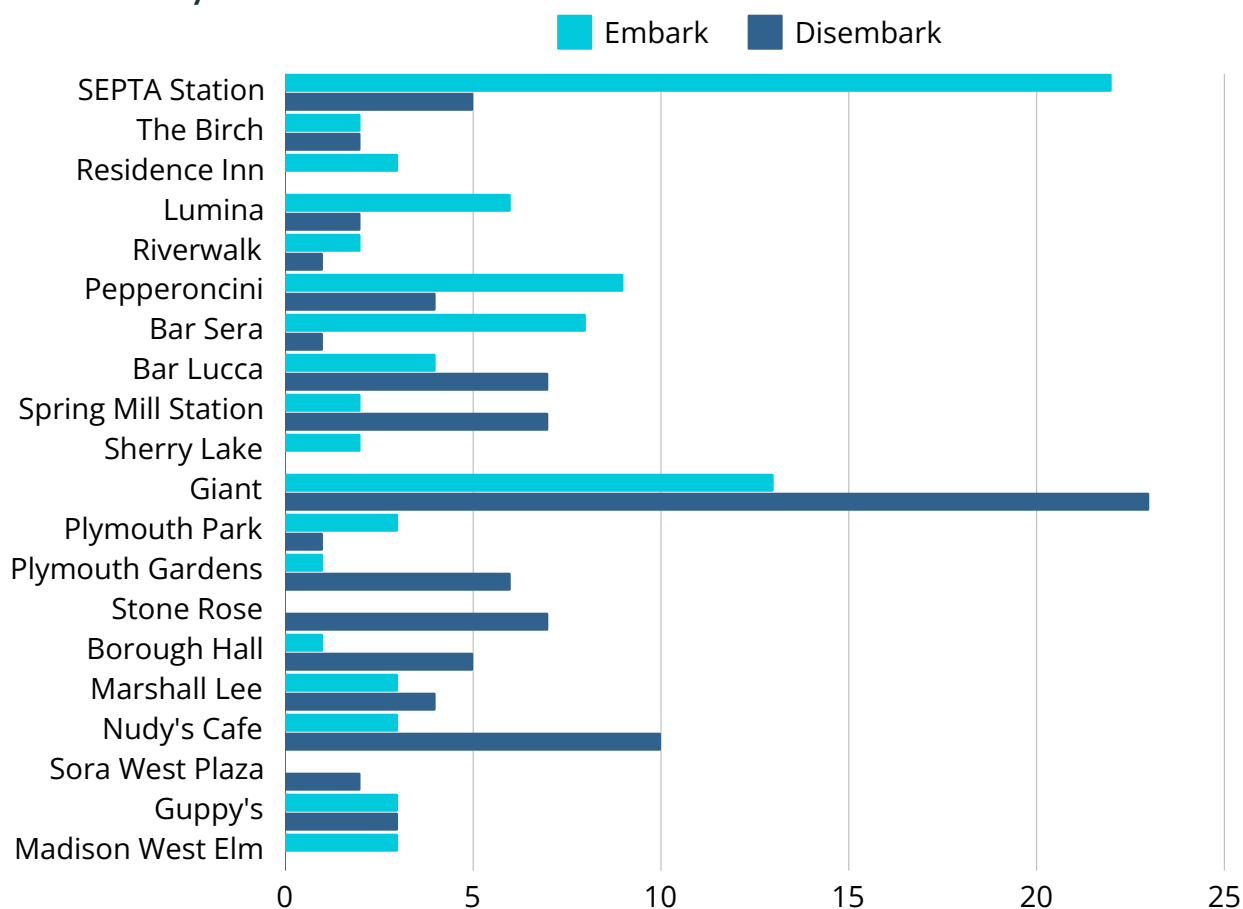

- Number of Days in Operation: 22
- Total Number of Rides Provided: 103
- Amount Collected in Fares: \$207.00

Adults buying individual tickets, using a 10-trip pass and represent 103 of the 131 total rides. Half of the total rides occurred on a Saturday, and 87% of the total rides occurred on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

The majority of the rides in March were on the daytime route. 106 total rides were provided from 11 am–6 pm on Wednesday–Saturday and on Sunday. 25 rides were provided from 6 pm–11 pm on Wednesday–Saturday.

Popular stops on the daytime route were Giant and Lumina. The most popular stop on the evening route was Guppy's Good Times.

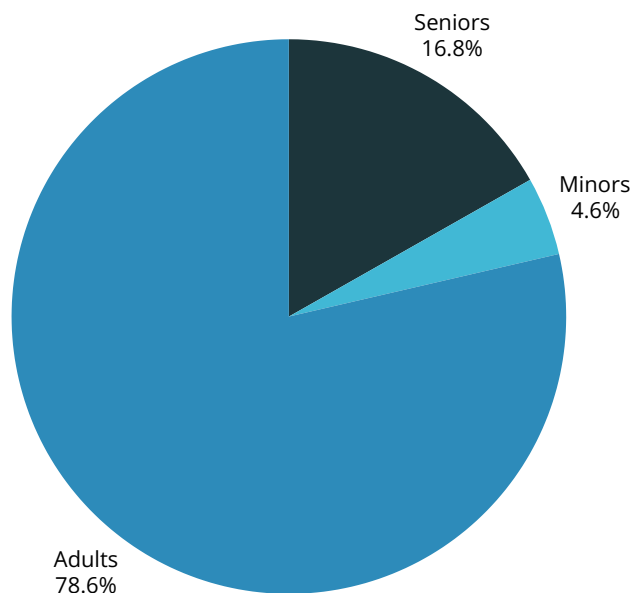
The Cab participated in the St. Patrick's Day parade on Saturday, March 15.

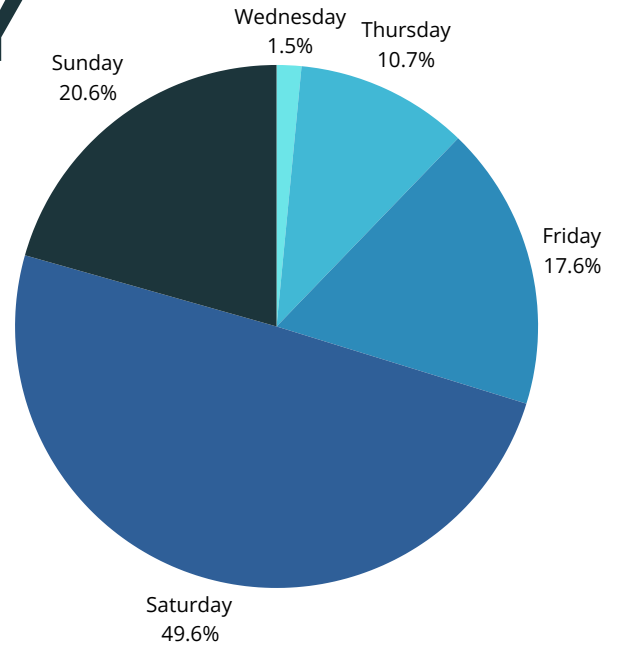

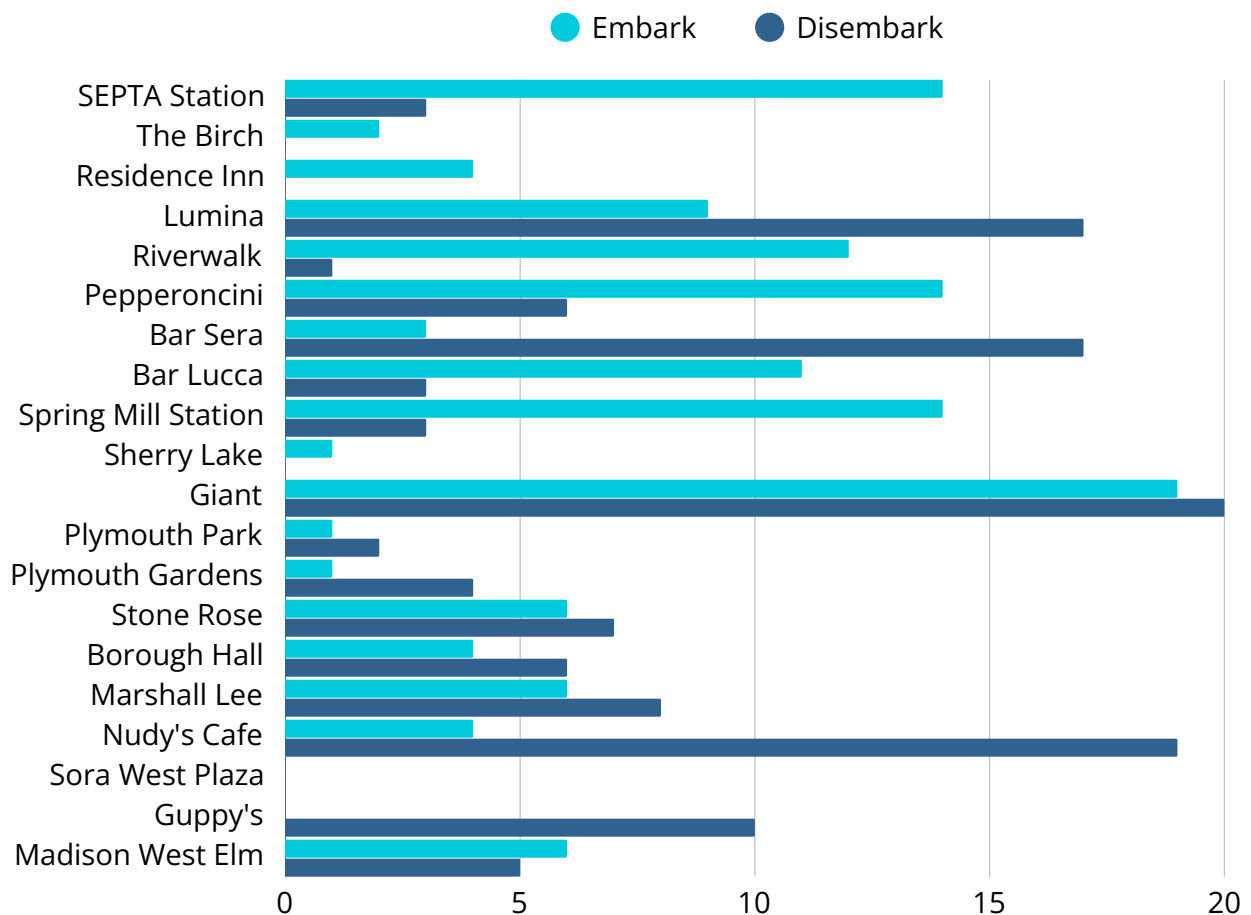

Adults buying individual tickets, using a 10-trip pass and represent 60 of the 99 total rides. Over two-thirds of the total rides occurred on Friday or Saturday.

Popular stops on the daytime route were Giant and the SEPTA Station. The most popular stop on the evening route was Nudy's Cafe.

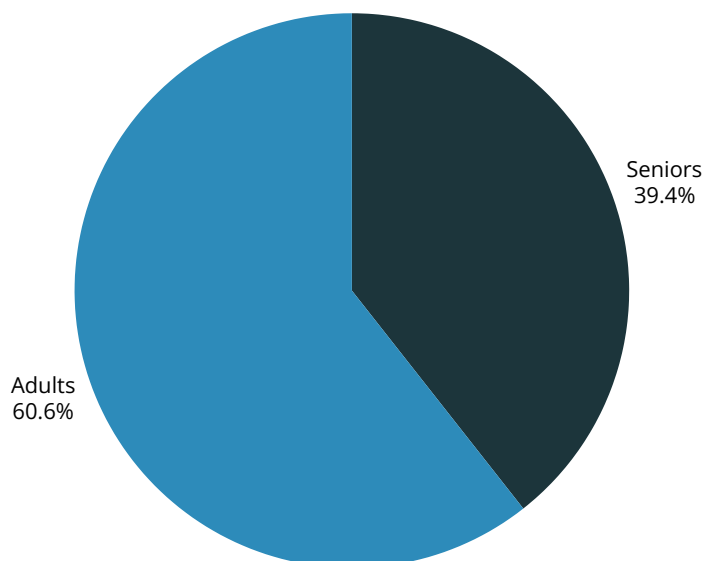

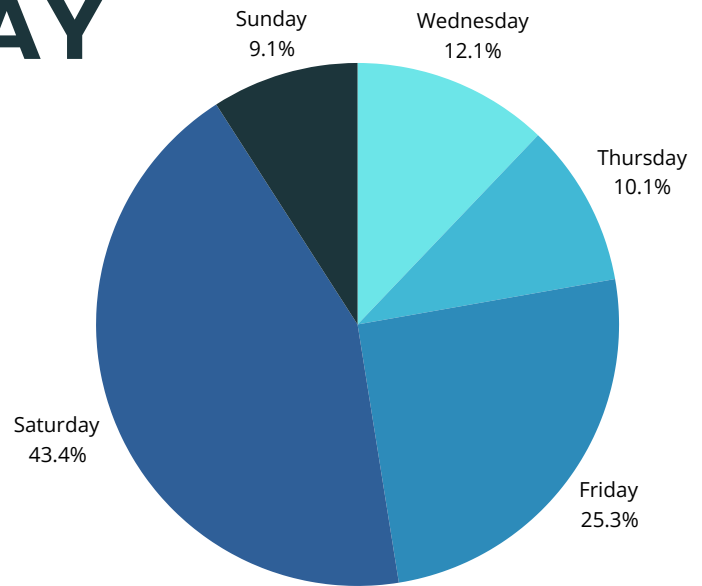

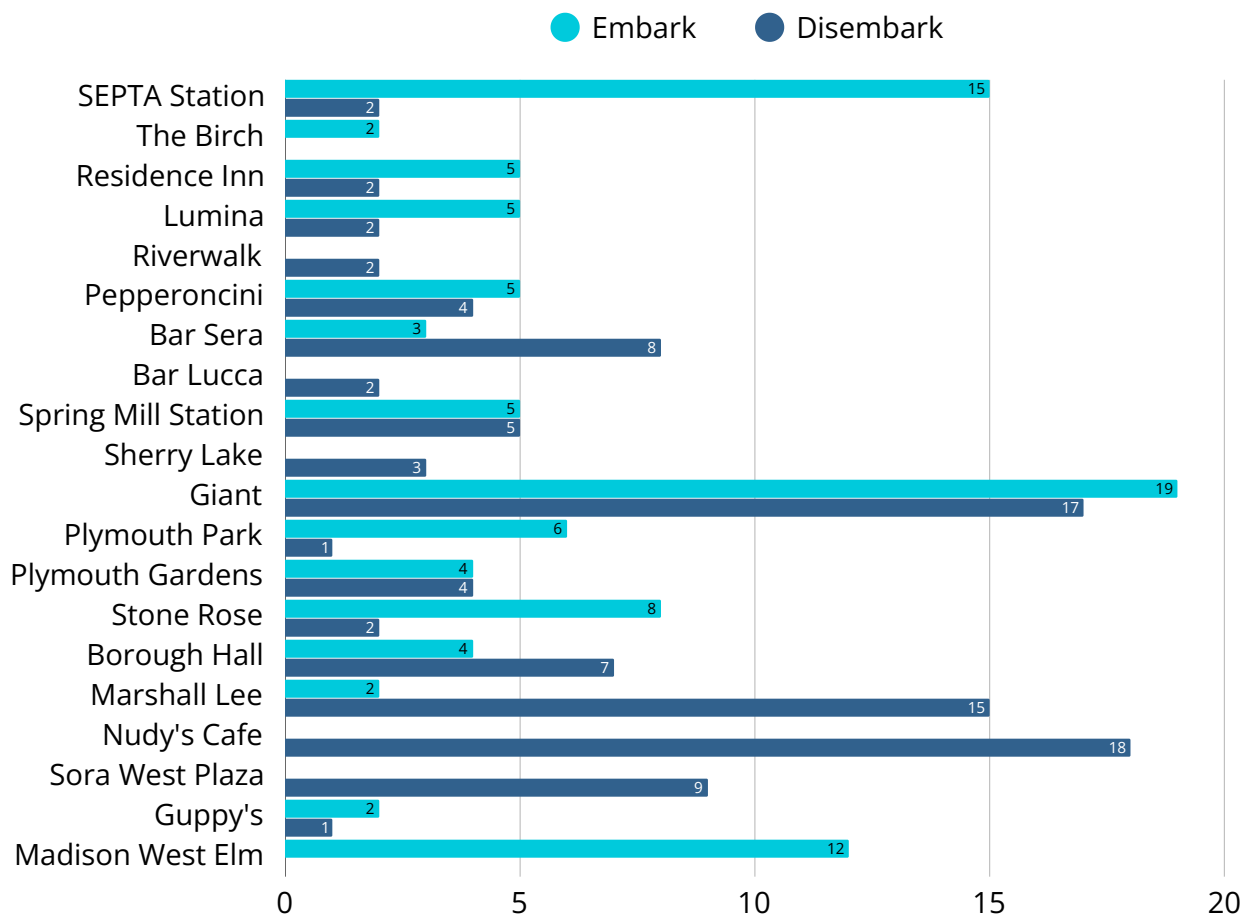

RIDERSHIP OVERVIEW

- Number of Days in Operation: 23
- Total Number of Rides Provided: 128
- Amount Collected in Fares: \$46.00

Adults buying individual tickets, using a 10-trip pass and represent 45 of the 87 rides on the normal route in May. Over half of the total rides on the normal route occurred on Friday or Saturday.

The majority of the rides in May were on the daytime route. 68 total rides were provided from 11 am–6 pm on Wednesday–Saturday and on Sunday. 19 rides were provided from 6 pm–11 pm on Wednesday–Saturday.

Popular stops on the daytime route were Giant and the SEPTA Station. The most popular stop on the evening route were Bar Sera and the SEPTA Station.

On Saturday, May 10, the Cab route was abbreviated during the Bike Race to accommodate the road closures, and then served as a shuttle between the Bike Race and the Borough's 175th Anniversary Celebration. No fares were collected on this day. The Cab ridership during the special event was 41 riders.

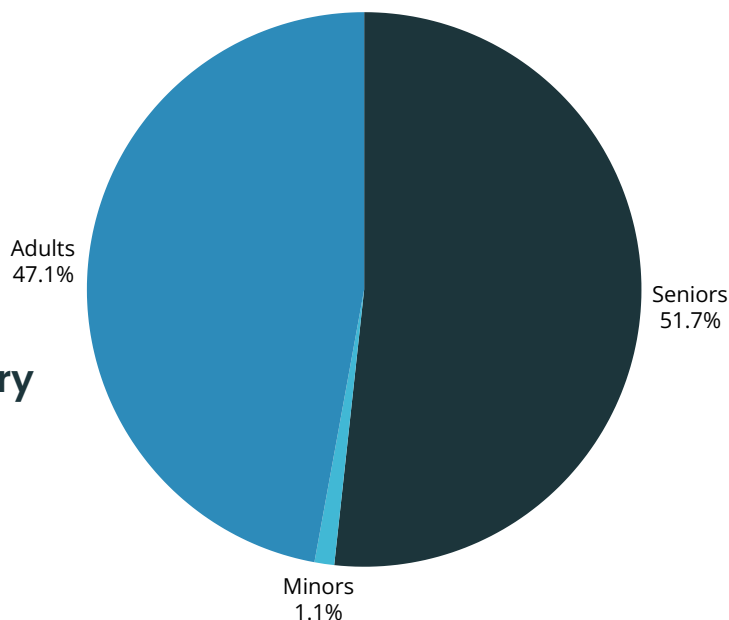

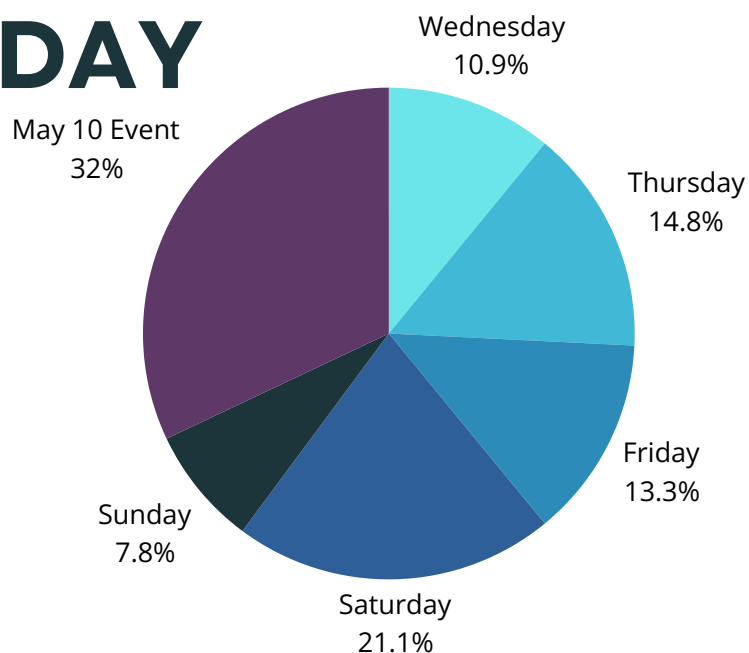

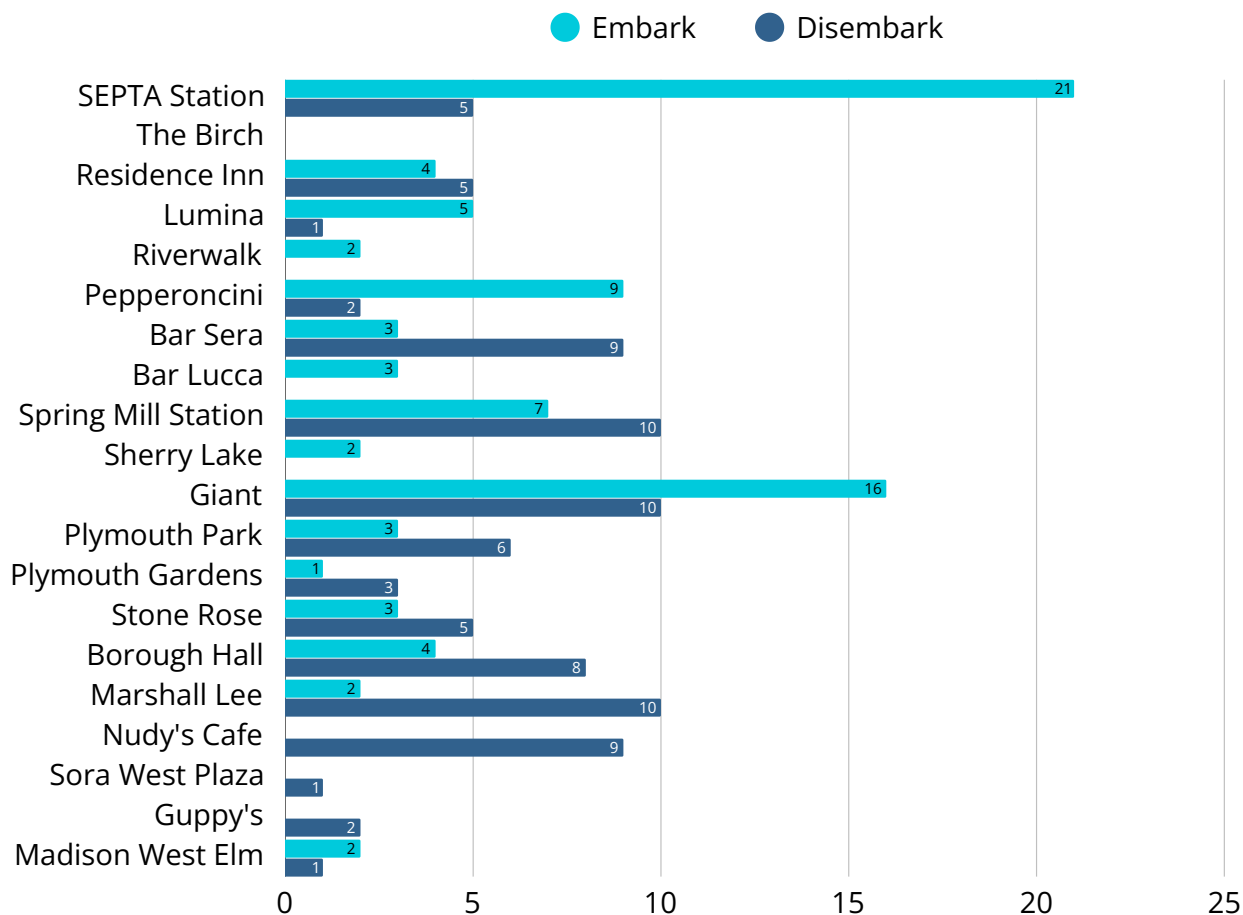

RIDERSHIP OVERVIEW

- Number of Days in Operation: 21
- Total Number of Rides Provided: 105
- Amount Collected in Fares: \$94.00

Adults buying individual tickets, using a 10-trip pass and represent 79 of the 105 rides on the normal route in June. This month, the ridership was more evenly spread out. Half of all rides were on a Friday or Saturday.

The rides in June were also evenly split between the daytime route and the evening route. 53 total rides were provided from 11 am–6 pm on Wednesday–Saturday and on Sunday. 152 rides were provided from 6 pm–11 pm on Wednesday–Saturday.

Popular stops on the daytime route were Giant and the SEPTA Station. The most popular stop on the evening route were the SEPTA Station and Madison West Elm.

GVF worked with the Borough of Conshohocken on additional promotions for the Cab, including free summer weekend rides beginning July 5.

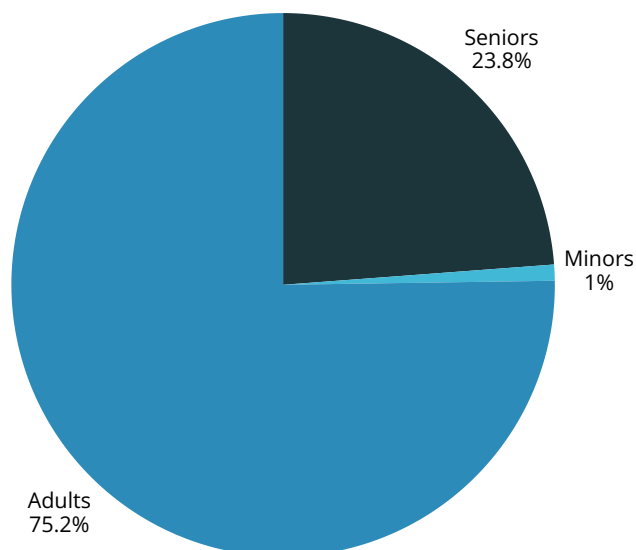

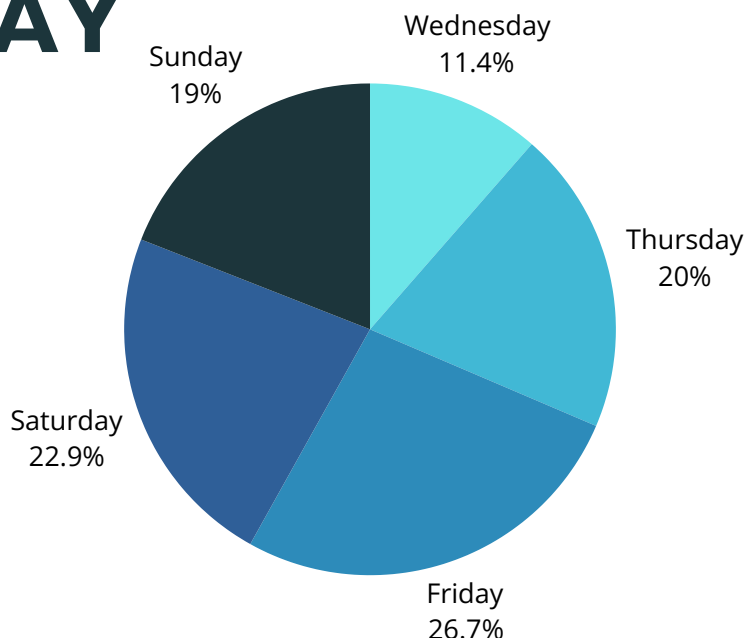

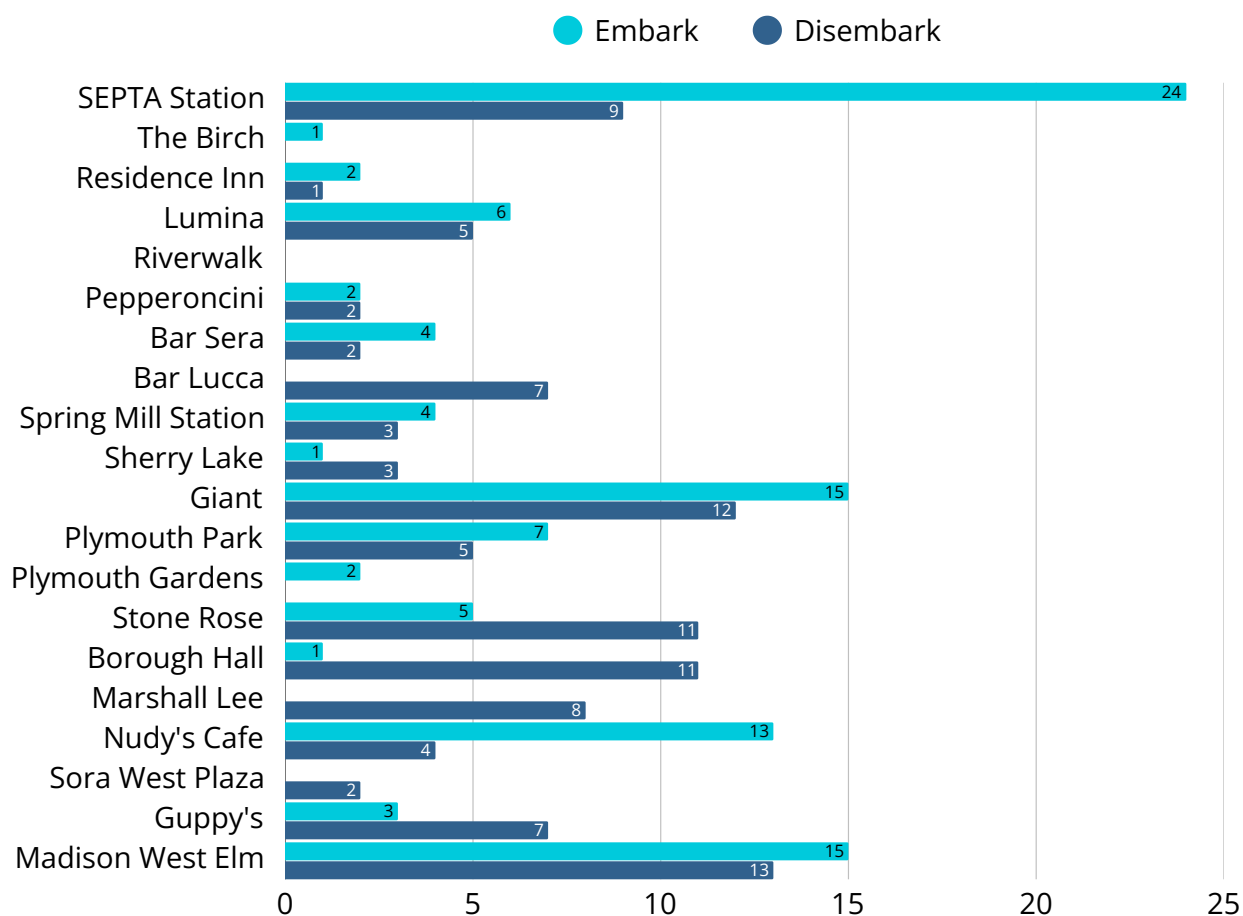

- Number of Days in Operation: 21
- Total Number of Rides Provided: 76
- Amount Collected in Fares: \$40.00

Beginning on Saturday, July 5, all rides on the Cab on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday were free.

Adults buying individual tickets, using a 10-trip pass, or a free weekend ticket represent 55 of the 76 rides during July. This month, over 83% of ridership occurred on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday.

Approximately two-thirds of the rides in July were on the daytime route. 48 total rides were provided from 11 am–6 pm on Wednesday–Saturday and on Sunday. 28 rides were provided from 6 pm–11 pm on Wednesday–Saturday.

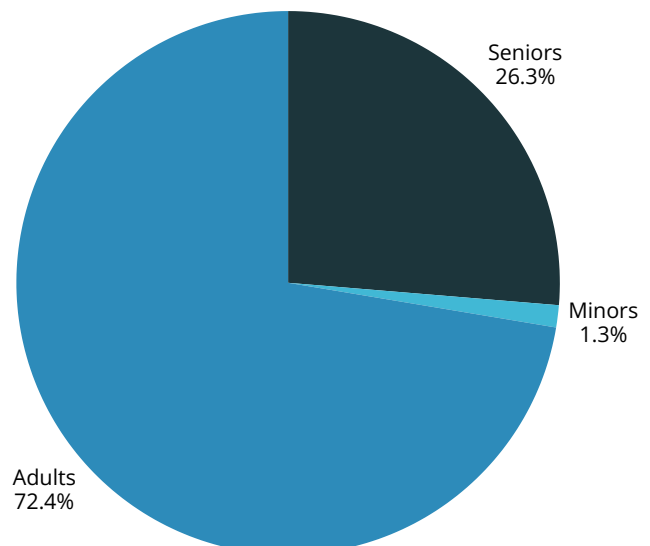
Popular stops on the daytime route were Giant and Madison West Elm. The most popular stop on the evening route were Nudy's and Madison West Elm.

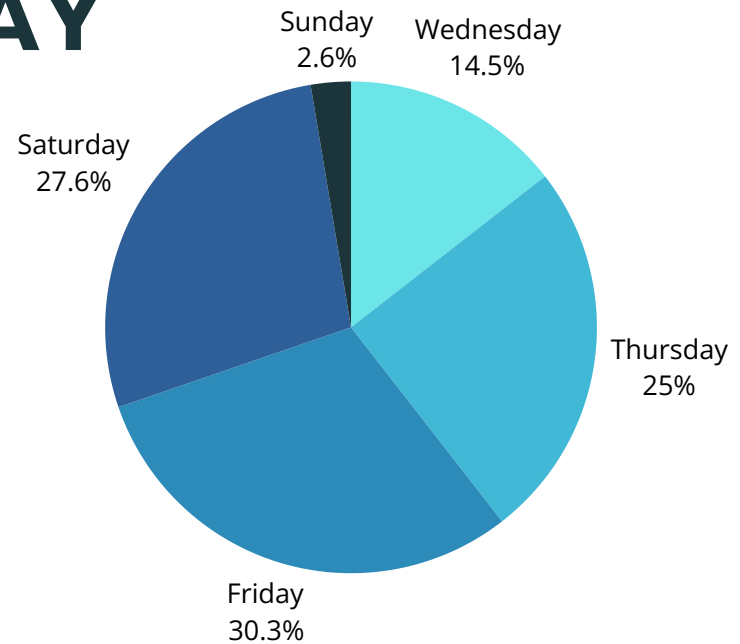
